# Year 4 Swimming update

This term Year 4 will begin their statutory swimming lessons. These will take place each Monday morning starting from 14th September to the end of December. Stockport have undertaken a thorough risk assessment to help support getting the children back swimming. We are aware that the cohort missed their school swimming lessons at the end of year 3, so want to give you and your child as much information as we can. The children will leave school at around 9:20am and travel by coach to Cheadle Swimming Pool. The children need to come with their swimming costume under their uniform to reduce time in the changing room. (Please remember to put underwear in their swimming kit bag) The children change in pairs in the cubicles.

The Swimming teachers employed by Stockport will assess the children during the first lesson. Any children needing floating aids will be given them to support their swimming development. Goggles are not allowed to be worn unless this is to support a medical need.

Earrings must be removed preferably before school. Staff cannot aid the children in removing or putting in earrings. If they are not removed the child will have to stay at school. All children with long hair MUST wear a swimming hat. Boys must wear tight fitting shorts not "baggy" board swimming shorts. At the end of the session the children will quickly get changed. The children will exit through the one way system at the pool to board the coach and return to school. Please make sure you provide a healthy snack on a Monday, as once back at school the children will eat their snack in their classroom, and are usually very hungry. #### Social Distancing

Please could we remind all parents to be aware of current social distancing guidelines when waiting outside the school gates. Parents should refrain from standing in groups and should remain 2 metres apart where possible. Also, it has come to our attention that parents are posting on Whatsapp groups when children are being tested for Covid even though, currently, all tests are negative. This is causing unnecessary anxiety amongst some of our parents. Could we please ask that you consider what you are about to post and the effect it could have on others. Thank you for your ongoing support in these circumstances.

#### Flu Vaccinations

Flu vaccinations will take place on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> October. We were hoping to have in place online e-consent forms, but due to an IT glitch with their NHS system we will have to revert to paper forms on this occasion. Vaccinations are for children in Reception to Year 6.

Consent forms will be sent home with children next week.

## School Crossing

The School Crossing Patrol Team are currently assessing the crossing service, in particular those over the age of 70 and those with underlying health conditions. Our patrol on Green Lane falls into this category, and subsequently there is no patrol on the crossing at present.
