# **BOOK SHARE VISIT**

Dear Parents With COVID restrictions more or less lifted we thought it would be a wonderful opportunity to invite you into school for a book share. This way you can spend time with your child in their classroom and have them explain what work they have been doing this year by sharing their books and learning environment with you. It would also be an opportunity for you to reconnect with staff and school face to face, something that I think we have all missed and would relish moving forward. Hence the 4 week notice period to make the necessary work and child care arrangements. We are still being asked to be conscious of having large numbers of visitors on site due to COVID and therefore can't have everyone attend on the same day or have the sessions running for a week or more across all classes.

I am sure you can appreciate that this would disrupt the children's learning too much. Instead we have planned our 'book share' over a two week period. Each Year group will have a dedicated 9-10am slot on a given day so that you can come in for a quick sneaky peak or stay longer, if work allows, to see what we have all been up to. By having dedicated year group timings it also means that parents can spend quality time and not feel rushed. Unfortunately, due to space and fire regulations, can we request that no pre-schoolers or buggies are brought into school. The Hive will also be open from 9.30-10.30am if you would like to grab a cup of tea or coffee and catch up with other parents from your child's class/year group. Parents wanting to visit need to wait on either the Early Years (Year R), KS1 (Years 1&2) or KS2 (Years 3-6) playground and then staff will invite you in as soon as the children have been registered.

You can then leave from the playgrounds at the end of your visit. Gates will be manned by school staff to ensure everyone's safety throughout. We ask that parents do not come onto the school site and into school if they have any COVID symptoms. Face masks although recommended do remain optional. Hopefully we will be able to build in more opportunities as we move into the summer term to have you visit.
