PE


Children will continue to have their weekly outdoor games session on a Tuesday afternoon with the school sports coaches.

English

This half term in English we will be looking at The Queen's Hat and The Queen's Handbag stories to develop and inspire our writing and comprehension skills. We will be continuing to focus on accurately writing a sentence using the high five. We will also be looking at continuing to improve our sentences by adding adjectives, conjunctions and different starters.



Music

In music the children will be learning songs from each decade of the Queen's life. We will play these songs at our Jubilee Party.

D & T

Textiles. We are going to be designing and making a new purse for our queen after researching symbols of the UK and the monarchy. We will try lots of different ways of attaching components and then make a decision which one to use.

Maths
