School is looking for volunteers to sand down and paint the metal container in Key Stage 2's playground. If you can help contact school either by telephone 0161 432 3944 or email:

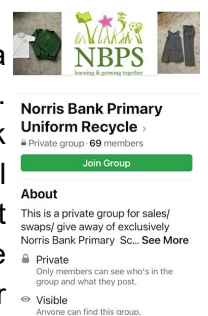

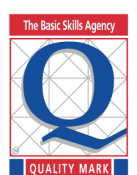
Congratulations
