Creative Curriculum How fast this year has gone! In our learning journey this half term, we will explore the Roman invasion of Britain and the impact that it had, as well as the reach of the Roman Empire. Much of our learning across the curriculum will be linked to this topic. We hope the children enjoy this final half term of Year 4!

English

We begin by practising reading skills, using texts linked to our topic. We will use the Romans as inspiration for writing news reports, play-scripts and suspense narrative. Following the residential, we will write poetry inspired by the visit. Weekly grammar lessons and daily reading activities, including Guided Reading, will continue.

Maths. We begin with telling the time and solving time problems, before moving onto line graphs. We will explore 2D shapes, angles and symmetry, We will finish using coordinates for position and direction.

Science Our final topic is Humans, Spelling tests will be on Tuesdays. where we find out more about our the organs in our digestive systems, as well as our teeth. There will be lots of interesting practical work to support our learning!
