Science

We will continue to classify living things into broad groups. We will carry out investigations about micro-organisms and explore our local habitats including our class tree.

Homework

This half term we will be running our homework slightly differently to the rest of the year. The children will continue to receive maths homework every Thursday and they will still be expected to read at least 4 times a week and have their reading log signed. However, they will not be receiving Grammar homework or reading task like they normally would.

Instead of this, we are giving them tree challenges to complete.

Challenge 2:- Continue practising their year 3/4/5 and 6 words for a test WB 18th July.

Challenge 3:- To create a piece of work relating to their given King or Queen (They will know who this is) e.g. poem, story, painting, model, etc. Please be as creative as you can. This will be due in for the week beginning the 18th July.

Topic

This half term our topic is called 'Leaders Through The Ages'. In this topic we will be looking at leaders from around the world as well as a focus on British Monarchs throughout the ages.

The children will also be given their own monarch to research and produce a non-fiction book about them.

English

This half term, we will be studying non-fiction books to identify a variety of features before writing and illustrating our own versions.

We will also be working hard on drama skills in preparation for the end-of-year production.

Finally, we will be looking at persuasive letters.

Music

Re

Maths

We will continue to revisit the Year 6 curriculum through investigations and practical activities such as, measuring, costing activities with Barclays Bank and applying their maths knowledge to a theme park development.

We will be following the Love Rocks unit which covers issues of healthy relationships and online safety and then work on transition to secondary school.
