Personal Social and Emotional Development

Getting ready for Year 1- we will be doing a lot of transition activities to support children in their move to Year 1. This will include celebrating their time in Reception. We will share our graduation with you at 2.30 on the 22nd July.

Literacy

Reading stories and non-fiction books linked to the topic. Consolidating Phase 4 phonic sounds and tricky words. Reading and writing our own stories, making fact books & following instructions. Writing high five sentences independently.

Maths Counting on and back in ones, twos, fives and tens. Doubling, halving & sharing. Problem solving activities. Addition and subtraction using a number line to count on and back.

Communication and Language

Retelling and developing their own narratives through role play and small world activities. Please encourage children to tell you what they have been learning in school.

Knowledge of the world Looking at life on the farm and a farmer's day. Learning about farm animals and what they do for us. Exploring programmable toys.

Physical Development

We will be getting ready for sports day which will be on 6th July. Please send pumps/trainers into school. We continue to develop fine motor skills- encouraging children to form all letters and numbers correctly.

Exploring colour mixing and making collages linked to our topic work.
