Christmas Request



Year 2 Artist Visit

Last week, Year 2 had an exciting visit from a local artist called Lucy Burgess for our 'hook' to the new Creative Curriculum 'Home Sweet Home' . She showed the children her work which includes key landmarks of Stockport. We then explored collage techniques to create our own art in a similar style to her work. The children were amazing, asked her interesting questions and worked hard throughout the art session. Great fun was had by all!

WW2 workshop

On Monday this week, Year 5 had a World War Il workshop in school. There were lots of opportunities to learn more about the war from our visiting expert. The children also had the chance to handle different artefacts from this time and find out how they were used. There were also some exciting practical activities to explore the role of ARP wardens, ranging from using stirrup pumps to put out fires and sand bags to manage incendiary bombs as well as developing first aid skills with bandaging and using stretchers to help people. 
