#### Yoga

Ainsley Howard, a reiki practitioner and a children/family and teen yoga and wellbeing teacher and Claire Ash, a trained yoga and mindfulness teacher, are running a Teen Wellbeing Workshop on Saturday 3rd February (see attached leaflet). Between them they have 35 years experience. Claire is currently teaching yoga to children at the school. The taster session is open to 8-12 year olds, will last 75 minutes and is completely free!



#### YR 1 Trip to Liverpool

On Tuesday Year 1 visited the Museum of Liverpool to enhance their creative curriculum topic. The children took part in a 'Transport Now and Then' workshop. As part of this workshop the children were allowed to go in the Liverpool Overhead Railway tram which is not open to the general public. The children were very excited to see the Speke Hall bath chair on display which they had been studying in school. We also saw the amazing steam train called Lion. We can not wait to share what we have learned with everyone in the Big Exhibition.











#### **Sport**

Stockport County are coming into school every Wednesday to teach footballing skills to the children. This is provided free of charge by the club.

#### **Leave of Absence Forms**

If your child needs time off from school for any reason, e.g. entrance exams, appointments, funerals etc. please complete a 'Leave of Absence' form, proof of the absence and return it to school in a timely manner. This can then be added to the register for the Education Welfare Service and will avoid any unnecessary phone calls to you.

The school office need this information **NOT** class teachers as they track attendance and absences across school. Teachers are welcome to be informed however all requests and paperwork **MUST** be done through the office.

Unfortunately, failure to do this could lead to an unauthorised absence and a fine.
