This half term our topic will be 'Location, Location, Location'. Will be comparing living in Heaton Moor to the Isle of Coll. To start this topic the children will be taking part in a treasure hunt using maps around the school grounds. Our final outcome for this topic is for the pupils to create their own map of an island location.

English

This half term in English we will be looking at the Katie Morag stories to develop and inspire our writing and comprehension skills. We will also be looking at improving our sentences by using adjectives and adding conjunctions. We will also be learning about where and how to use exclamation marks.



Maths

This half term in maths we will be looking at length, height, weight and volume. We will be learning how to make accurate measurements and compare these measurements. During this unit we will continue to consolidate our addition and subtraction skills in context.

ICT

This half term in ICT we are starting a computer coding unit. We will be learning to code using 2Code on Purple Mash. We will

start at the beginning of the Chimp modules learning to give the programme instructions using simple code blocks.



PE

Children will continue to have their weekly outdoor games session on a Tuesday afternoon with the school sports coaches.

Music

In music the children will be exploring different instruments to make seaside sounds. They will then be using symbols to represent sounds and use these to create a musical score. Then the children will use the Purplemash programme 2sequence to record their final compositions electronically.



PSHE

This term in PSHE we will be learning about jobs in the community. We will look at strengths and skills different people have and how these are used when carrying out a job.



On Tuesday mornings we also continue with gymnastics with Mrs Buchanan working on their BAGA awards.



Art

In art we will be using the work of William Turner to inspire our own seascapes paintings. Before creating these the children will be learning to create tints, tones and shades. We will be exploring how



paint can be applied with a range of different tools e.g. cotton buds, sponges etc. We will also be looking at creating texture by adding sand, glitter, glue, salt etc.

Geography

In Geography we will be comparing Heaton Moor and the Isle of Coll. We will be learning where these places are in the U.K. We will be learning to describe the key features of these localities. We will also be looking at similarities and differences. We will be looking at and using a range of maps, atlas and aerial pictures throughout this topic.
