Maths

This half term we have begun on topic learning about Roman Numerals. We will be learning to read the time, using analogue and digital clocks and convert to the 24 hour clock. We will learn how to calculate the area and perimeter of regular, irregular and rectilinear shapes. We finish off learning about symmetry and translation in shapes; measuring and comparing angles and line/bar charts in statistics.
