A: Lyme can be accessed by car from the A6, bus via the 199 route, or train via Disley station on the Buxton train line from Stockport. 10% discount can be claimed in the café on presentation of a bike helmet or a valid bus or train ticket.

Q: Can we use this pass multiple times?

A: This is a single use offer.
