

This half term in English we will be looking at writing letters. We will be using the story of the Queen's Hat to stimulate our ideas and writing, alongside our London tour and our History and geography work, to write a letter home about a visit to London. We will be exploring using conjunctions, capital letters for days of the week and place names and a variety of punctuation.



Maths

We will also begin to look at time and use time words as well as identifying the time to the nearest hour and half hour.
